<p data-bbox="235 514 397 556">Reading</p> <p data-bbox="203 640 349 714">Try 1 task per day</p>	<ul data-bbox="495 451 1404 1176" style="list-style-type: none">• Login to Epic Books or RAZ Kids, read a book to yourself, listen to a book being read, and take a quiz.• Make a tongue twister! First, pick a letter. Next, write down as many words as you can think of that start with that letter. Then, make up a sentence using as many of your words as possible. Lastly, challenge everyone at home to say it as fast as they can!• Syllable Separator Game: Roll a die and try to come up with a word that has as many syllables as the number shown. If you can't think of a word with many syllables, say a sentence that make up the number. For example, if you roll a 6 you could say "Mommy and daddy rock!".• Choose a poem to read aloud. Try the one below or another of your choice.
