- Choose a story book to read. As you read your story, think about what the main character might be thinking at some important parts of the story. Using sticky notes or small pieces of paper, draw a thought bubble and write the words your character might be thinking inside.
- Before reading about an ocean animal of your choice, complete the first page in the [Ocean Animal Inquiry](#) (click here or see below). Write what you already know about your chosen animal in the K section for “know”. Write what you want to know in the W section for “want to know”. Once you’ve read about your animal. Write what you learned in the L section for “learned”.
- Complete the second page in the Ocean Animal Inquiry – Research Notes. Write/draw what your animal looks like, eats, how they behave, if they have an enemies, and some interesting facts that you learned.
- Complete the last page of the Ocean Animal Inquiry – Write a story about your animal. Use your research notes to help you.
- Complete the Ocean Animal Life Cycle Wheel.
