<p data-bbox="235 514 397 562">Reading</p> <p data-bbox="203 636 349 716">Try 1 task per day</p>	<ul data-bbox="500 451 1421 871" style="list-style-type: none"><li data-bbox="500 451 1421 619">• Happy Mother's Day! Read or listen to <i>The Day My Mom Came To Kindergarten</i> on Epic Books. Take the quiz. What do you think would happen if your mom came to school for the day?<li data-bbox="500 646 1421 871">• Ask your mom if she has a favourite story about moms (<i>Maybe I'll Love You Forever?</i>). Read it together. If she doesn't, look for another Mother's Day story on Epic! Books (see the Happy Mother's Day collection) and read it together. <p data-bbox="500 898 1421 1071">• A Haiku is a short poem that is made up of 3 lines with a specific number of syllables in each line. Line 1: 5 syllables, Line 2: 7 syllables, Line 3: 5 syllables. For example, see these 2 poems below:</p> <p data-bbox="500 1113 974 1291">"Dear mom, did you know?
